Until receipt of this enrollment fee, the SCHOOL reserves the right to offer the place to another prospective student.

III. Activities Fee

PARENT(S) hereby agree to pay the school's tuition and activities fee (Jewish Studies books, materials, and field trips) in accordance with the rate schedule above for the 2011-2012 Academic Year and corresponding to the Grade Level in which CHILD has been enrolled.

IV. Multiple Child Discount

Tuition charges are discounted 10% for a second child and 15% for a third child form the same family enrolled in the SCHOOL.

V. Lunch Program

Enrollment Contract for 2011-2012

To reserve a space, this original Enrollment Contract must be returned to the SCHOOL signed by at least one PARENT or a LEGAL GUARDIAN, and tuition payment plan option initialed, along with the payment of the non-refundable enrollment fee of \$500 by the stated deposit due date. Enrollment decisions for students with incomplete Contracts or Contracts submitted after the due date will be made on a space-available basis.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PARENTAL COOPERATION CLAUSE

The Martin J. Gottlieb Day School (MJGDS) believes that a positive and constructive working relationship between the MJGDS and a student's parents (or legal guardians) is essential to the fulfillment of the MJGDS's mission. Thus, MJGDS reserves the right to discontinue enrollment or not to re-enroll a student if the MJGDS reasonably concludes that the actions of a parent (or legal guardian) make such a positive and constructive relationship impossible or otherwise seriously interfere with the MJGDS accomplishment of its educational purposes. The MJGDS also reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any student at any time if, in the judgement of the Head of School, such action is deemed to be in the best interest of the school or of the student. This decision may be based on the conduct of the family as well as the student. No refund of tuition, fees, or costs will be made for suspension or dismissal at any time.

AUTHORITY

Each party represents and warrants to the other party that it has full power and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this Contract and this Contract constitutes it legal, valid and binding obligation, enforceable in accordance with its terms. PARENTS, in two-parent households, agree that each is acting as agent for the other. Modifications to this parental agency relationship shall be in writing and delivered to the SCHOOL. No oral modifications will be recognized or accepted.

APPLICABLE LAW AND VENUE

This Contract shall be interpreted according to the laws of the State of Florida and shall be enforced in a court of competent jurisdiction within Duval County, Florida.

AMENDMENTS

This Contract may only be amended by mutual agreement of the parties, provided that the amendment is in writing and is executed by both parties.

I understand that neither report cards nor transcripts of courses and grades will be sent to any school until all financial obligations of this Contract have been met.
